# Disabled Population in Haryana 2011: A Geographical Analysis

Abstract: The present study has conducted on Haryana at district level in 2011. The study has been carried out to find out the pattern of disable population in Haryana by their disabilities such as seeing, hearing, speech, movement, mental retardation, mental illness, multiple disability and other disabilities. Data has been taken from Census of India 2011. Data has analyzed with the help of simple statistical techniques, tables and graphs and pattern has been shown with the help of ARC GIS 9.3 software. The result shows that there are 82,702 persons are suffering from seeing, 1,15,527 persons are suffering from hearing problem, 21,787 persons are suffering from speech problem, 1,16,026 persons suffering from movement problem, 30,070 persons are suffering from mental retardation, 16,191 persons are suffering from mental illness and 47,250 persons are suffering from Multiple Disability. Faridabad has the highest persons with seeing and hearing disability, persons with speech disability in Hisar, persons with movement and Mental Retardation in Karnal, persons with mental illness and multiple disabled in Yamunanagar stands at first.

### Introduction

Human is an incredible resource of earth. Any disability in his physical or mental ability highly affects his functions as well as development of that region from which they belongs. So, it becomes very important to study about these persons and find out their pattern. It helps to make policies for these peoples. Disability is the consequence of an impairment that may be physical, cognitive, mental, sensory, emotional, developmental, or some combination of these. A disability may be present from birth, or occur during a person's lifetime.

According to Oxford Dictionary A physical or mental condition that limits a person's movements, senses, or activities. A disability is an umbrella term, covering impairments, activity limitations, and participation restrictions. Impairment is a problem in body function or structure; an activity limitation is a difficulty encountered by an individual in executing a task or action; while a participation restriction is a problem experienced by an individual in involvement in life situations (WHO 2012).

Thus disability is a complex phenomenon, which is the result of physical and mental impairment. In 2011, in India 2,68,10,557 (1,49,86,202 male and 1,18,24,355 females) persons are belonged to disabled population. The percentage share of disabled population in India is 2.13 per cent in 2001, and it increased to 2.21 percent in 2011. In Haryana 1.9 percent population belongs to disabled population in 2011.

### Study Area

The Present study has been conducted on Haryana state. Map 1 shows the location of Haryana in India. Haryana is a landlocked state in northern India. It is bounded on the north-west by the state of Punjab and the Union Territory of Chandigarh, on the north and north-east by the states of Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand, on the east by the state of Uttar Pradesh and the Union Territory of Delhi, and on the south and south-west by the state of Rajasthan. It is located between 27°37' to 30°53' N latitude and between 74°28' and 77°36' E longitude. The name of Haryana is derived from Hari (the Hindu god Vishnu) and ayana (home), means "The Abode of God". The total geographical area of Haryana is 44,212 square kilometre. Haryana is a small State with 2.53 Lakh (Census of India 2011) populations. For administrative purposes, the State has been divided into 21 Districts.

Map 1: Location map of Haryana



## **Objectives**

The study has been carried out to fulfil following objectives:

- ❖ To find out the district pattern of Disabled population in Haryana in 2011.
- To find out the district wise disabled population by their disabilities in Haryana in 2011.
- To find out the district-wise percentage share of disabled population in Haryana in 2011.

### **Data Source and Methodology**

This study covers Haryana at district level and based on secondary data, collected from Census of India 2011 and Statistical Abstract Haryana 2011-12. Data has been analysed with the help of general statistical techniques and presented with the help of appropriate graphs and tables. ARC GIS 9.3 software is also used to represent the geographical pattern of disabled population in Haryana.

# Pattern of Disabled Population in Haryana in 2011

Nearby 2 percent (1.9 percent) population of Haryana falls under the category of disability. 16.57 percent persons are influence by seeing problem, 23.15 percent persons with hearing problem, 4.37 percent have speech problem, 23.25 percent have affected with movement problem, 6.02 percent are affected with mental retardation and 3.24 percent are affected with mental illness. 47,250 persons are affected with multiple disabilities. Table 1 represents district-wise disabled population according their disabilities in Haryana in 2011.




Figure 2: District-wise percent share of disabled Population in Haryana in 2011




It clearly shows that Faridabad stand first in persons with seeing disability where as Panchkula stands at last. In hearing disabilities, Feridabad stand first whereas stands at last. In movement disability Sirsa stands first and Panchkula at last.






Figure 4: District-wise Disabled (Speech, M.R. & Mental Illness) Population in Haryana in 2011



It clearly shows that Hisar stands in first in persons disabled with speech problem and Panchkula at last. In persons with mental retardation population Karnal stands at first and Panchkula stands at last. Persons with mental illness population Yamunanagar stands at first and Palwal at last.

### Conclusion

The percentage share of disabled population in India is 2.13 per cent in 2001, and it increased to 2.21 percent in 2011. In Haryana 1.9 percent population belongs to disabled population in 2011. Faridabad, Hisar and Karnal have first, second and third number in disabled population. These three districts have 22.77 percent disabled population of total disabled population of Haryana. Feridabad stand first in persons with seeing disability where as Panchkula stands at last. In hearing disabilities, Feridabad stand first whereas stands at last. In movement disability Sirsa stands first and Panchkula at last. Hisar stands in first in persons disabled with speech problem and Panchkula at last. In persons with mental retardation population Karnal stands at first and Panchkula stands at last. Persons with mental illness population Yamunanagar stands at first and Palwal at last.
