MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE PORTAL


- 1. The portal envisages providing one stop solution to the educational requirements of learning ranging from K to 20 covering all fields of study including vocational education and learning of life skills.

SAKSHAT'S STRUCTURE



It is established at IGNOU representing three tier architecture with presentation, logic developed using HTML, Java script as ASP.Net,business logic written in VB.Net and C# and the data repository in running on SQL server 2000.
