Swalpahari, grihtyaagi,

Vidyaarthi panch lakshnam”.

1. Kaag Chesta (Perseverance of a Crow)

Efforts should be similar to a crow.: - Students should always try like a crow, wherever knowledge is being received, it should be accepted.

2. Bako Dhyanam (Concentration of a Swan):- To focus your attention like a heron, just like a heron meditates to catch a fish in the water, in the same way students should focus their attention on acquiring knowledge.

3. Shwan Nindra (Light Sleeper like a Dog): - This swan means dog, just as a dog wakes up at the sound of light, no one is lazy, similarly a student should never be lazy.

4. Alp-ahari (Light Eater): - The student should always eat less so that his digestion process remains healthy and laziness does not come.

5. Grih Tyagi (Less involvement in Home matters) :- The student should always have positive thoughts, should respect elders and teachers, should love the younger ones.

That means student life is a life of meditation and penance. This period is of study and knowledge-contemplation with concentrated mind. This period is the period to keep yourself away from worldly distractions. For the students, this life is a golden opportunity to provide a solid foundation to themselves.

Meaning of personality:- The word personality is used in different meanings. Sometimes it explains behavior, sometimes mental ability, sometimes it is used as a skill of adjustment and sometimes it explains physical appearance.

Literal meaning of personality :- The word personality is the Hindi variation of the word personality of the English language. The word personality is derived from the Latin persona. The word persona refers to a type of costume that an artist wears during a play to play a particular role on the stage. But the person's personality becomes different from the reality by the mask or dress. In this sense personality is understood on the basis of external qualities of a person, but it does not explain the real meaning of personality.

In general, personality is understood to include those qualities that help in establishing one's influence on others. Thus those characteristics of individuals which help in influencing others; comes under personality. According to philosophical ideology, personality means self-knowledge and complete ideal. The form of knowledge and its idealism are included in the mental structure of the individual.

According to the sociological point of view, under personality, those qualities are included which determine the work and position of the person in the society. Social effectiveness is the dominant trait according to this approach. According to the psychoanalytic ideology, there are three major parts of the personality, the id, the ego and the superego. The basic instincts of the unconscious mind are related to reality and seek fulfillment. Ego restricts this power with discretion, logic and consciousness. Ego power only gets the real behavior done. The ability to behave in accordance with the society arises from Paraham.

Therefore, these three powers are effective in the individual. According to the psychological point of view, the complete organization of the individual which occurs at any stage of development is included under personality.

Student's personality qualities :- Student life is very full of struggle, by staying in this struggle, students become successful in life. And in this success, the various personality qualities of the student make the student life successful.

The following are the personality traits of a good student.

1. **Physical Qualities:-** Length, width, build, weight, complexion, sound etc. are the physical qualities of the student. These qualities have a special impact on the personality of the student.
2. **Mental qualities:-** The mental qualities of the student include knowledge, emotion, nature, desire, tendency etc. qualities.

The qualities of cooperation, sympathy, sacrifice, public interest etc. are an integral part of the student.
5. **Determination power:** - It is said that whatever a student thinks or decides in his mind, he leaves it by doing that means the determination power of the student's personality is an important part. Willpower plays a very important role in determining personality. It is through this that the thinking power increases and the personality improves. Because of this quality, Gandhiji, Subhash Chandra Bose, Shivaji, A. P.J Abdul Kalam etc. became great men. Strong will gives the student so much ability that by struggling even in difficult situations, he can make his personality excellent. If this power is lacking then the life of the student also gets disintegrated. Due to strong will power, it is easy for the student to achieve the goal.

6. **Emotional qualities** :- Emotion makes the student successful and more successful. Feelings, impulses, and physical and somatic processes and procedures all come under emotion. These qualities or characteristics get mixed and appear in different categories. Anger, quarrelsomeness, sympathy, love, fear, worry, happiness, laughter, etc. are the emotions that appear depending on the situation. A person's emotions explain the type of personality. This gives an understanding of the nature of the student.
7. **Spirit of social service** :- Social service is also an important part of student's life and plays a role in developing his personality. If the student serves the society in the right way, then he plays a strong role not only in the progress of the society but also in nation building.
8. **Harmony** :- There are many dimensions and areas of personality from which personality is created, such as different character traits, behavior, structure, living, and speed etc., establishing harmony among all these is the specialty of personality.
9. **Continuity of development** :- The development of the student's personality is a continuous process, as the student's actions, thoughts, experiences, situations, etc. change, the personality of the student also changes or the process changes. It continues from birth till death.
