

Study of the Effect of Social Status on the Educational Achievement and Adjustment Ability of Secondary School Children

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ABSTRACT

The main objective of the present research is to study the effect of adjustment on the academic achievement of secondary level students. For this study, a total of 100 students studying in secondary level school of Rohtak district have been selected as a sample for the study. A list on adjustment for school students prepared by the principal has been used and the secondary school students of class 8 have been used as the basis for the measurement of academic achievement. Mean standard deviation, critical translation and correlation statistics methods have been used for the analysis. After the analysis, it has been found that a positive correlation was found in the academic achievement and adjustment of secondary level students. That is, the students whose academic achievement is high, their socio-economic level of adjustment is also high and the students whose educational achievement level is low, the adjustment ability and social level are also low, the acceptance of the society for the child going to school. It is very important. The child who is accepted by the society. He gets adjusted easily in the school. Generally the student has high social status. He remains the center of attraction among the other students of the school. On the other hand, students of low social level are unable to adjust themselves, social level directly affects the academic achievement of the students. This creates a feeling of inequality among the students. According to the present study, the academic achievement and adjustment ability of the children has been found to be less as compared to the students of higher social status.

Educational achievement is the knowledge acquired in school subjects, the developed skill is specified by the teacher by the marks obtained in the examination. Its numerical representation is the indicator of academic achievement. Academic achievement or academic performance is the extent to which a student, teacher or institution has achieved its short or long term educational goals. Meeting educational benchmarks such as a secondary school diploma and bachelor's degree represents academic achievement. Academic achievement is usually measured through examinations or continuous evaluation but there is no general agreement on how it is best assessed.
